Excerise

The course contains a mixture of lectures and practical exercises. Students learn to implement Automotive SPICE 3.0 based on a case study.

Position 2 – Exams

Exams are organised by VDA. Exam fees need to be paid to the training body who has to refund the VDA.

The exam takes place on Friday afternoon, the 5th day of the course.

Cost and Invoicing

Option 1: Sending attendees to an open course

1.) 1 Attendee sent to the course:

Position 1. Competent Assessor Course

Each participant pays a fee of 2750 EUR per person.

Position 2. Competent Assessor Course Exam

Exam fees are charged per person taking the exam. The exam fee is 550 Euro each.

Total Overall Cost for 1 person: 2750 (Training) + 550 (Exam) = **3300 Euro**

2.) 2 Attendees sent to the course:

Position 1. Competent Assessor Course

Each participant pays a fee of 2200 EUR per person.

Position 2. Competent Assessor Course Exam

Exam fees are charged per person taking the exam. The exam fee is 550 Euro each.

Total Overall Cost for 2 persons: 4400 (Training) + 550 x 2 (Exam) = **5400 Euro**

3.) 3 Attendees sent to the course:

Position 1. Competent Assessor Course

Each participant pays a fee of 2000 EUR per person.

Position 2. Competent Assessor Course Exam

Exam fees are charged per person taking the exam. The exam fee is 550 Euro each.

Total Overall Cost for 3 persons: 6000 (Training) + 550 x 3 (Exam) = **7650 Euro**

Option 2: Organising an in-house course

A fixed price of 11000 EUR is calculated. The number of attendees is max. 15. The travel cost of the trainer need to be covered additionally.

Also the VDA exam fee of 550 EUR per person applies.
